### **General Information about admission:**

- 1. Both Kuwaiti and other nationalities may apply
- All applicants must complete the registration form and apply for admission in person at the Admission and Registration Section of College of Graduate Studies, building number KH 2-second floor in Khaldiya.
- 3. Requirements for application
  - a. A bachelor's degree in a health-related field.
  - b. A minimum overall Grade Point Average (GPA) score of 2.67 points with a minimum specialization average of 3.00 points.
  - c. A minimum TOEFL score of 500 (or equivalent).
  - d. An essay describing reasons for wishing to study Public Health and indicating career plans and objectives.
  - e. 3 recommendation letters.
- 4. All applications will be evaluated by a Committee
- 5. Applicants will be invited for a written test and an interview by the Committee.
