

Prof Gasana is environmental & occupational health (EOH), epidemiology and medicine professional born in Rwanda with more than 25 years of experience in EOH and safety in Rwanda, Haiti, Ethiopia, Cameroon, USA, and Kuwait. His research explores the role of environmental and occupational exposures to soil-, water-, air-, and food-borne contaminants; infections; allergens; injury; stress; genes; & the immune system in the pathological process that leads to the disease with the ultimate goal of controlling/preventing these exposures using exposure assessment, community-based pilot studies, meta-analysis / systematic reviews, and analysis of secondary data. Currently teaches the online Introductory EOH course for Medical College of Wisconsin (since 2015) and is developing capacity in Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) using blended learning (online and onsite with field visits) particularly in mining in Africa (via African OSH experts in Diaspora). Is on Advisory Panel for HSE (Health Safety & Environment) Forums that are organized yearly in Kuwait by London-based Alain Charles Publishing; HSE refers to the notion that a great company has to be responsible for the observance and protection of occupational health and safety rules and regulations along with environmental protection. Is HSE Consultant for The World Bank and British Department For International Development. Is OHS, & Environment for USAID. As a capacity builder, was founding faculty member of EOH Dept of Robert Stempel School of Public Health at Florida International University (FIU) in Miami where he was a professor for 20 years; for ten years, singlehandedly took care and taught all the courses (alternating online & onsite teaching) of the concentration of EOH sciences in the then FIU Department of Public Health which evolved into the School (in 2002).
