Program Overview

Curriculum Components

Coursework (Minimum 45 credit hours (hrs)

- Core courses (21 credit hrs)
- Concentration courses (10 credit hrs.)
- Elective courses (9 credit hrs.)
- CGS courses (5 credit hrs).

Full time student are expected to complete the program and graduate in two years (Four semesters).

Capstone Project

As an alternative to an MPH thesis. Students are required to complete a directed capstone project with a faculty advisor. Capstone research involves development and implementation of a research proposal on a specific public health problem, data analysis, writing and submission of a technical report.

Practicum

Students are attached to a community-based healthcare delivery site. Students are mentored and at sites, their activities are observed during the entire practicum period. The students keep a log of their on-sites professional activities, prepare and present a report on their training and contributions in their respective sites.

Admission Requirements

- GPA score of 2.67 points, MGPA score of 3.00 on a scale of 4.00 with the following exceptions:
- 1. Medical and dental candidates with GPA score of 2.00 points on a scale of 4.00 can apply for MPH program.
- Medical and pharmacists candidates with MGPA score of 2.00 points on a scale of 4.00 can apply for MPH program.
- Both Kuwaitis and non Kuwaitis can apply for the program.
- TOEFL score of ≥ 500 or IELTS score of ≥ 5.
- GRE (Preferred but not required)
- Passing the admission test.
- · Passing an interview.
- Working experience in the public health sector is a plus
- Other requirements: Three reference letters, an essay on why you are interested and future professional goals, transcript, and any other (please refer to CGS).
