Applications are invited for the position of a Health Economist in the Department of Community Medicine and Behavioural Sciences. Candidates may apply for appointment at the rank of Assistant, Associate or Full Professor.

Applicants should have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in a field of study that provides a foundation for specialisation in Economics, Health Economics, or Health Economics and Policy. They should also have a first degree in a relevant field. Applicants should also have a demonstrated interest in conducting individual and collaborative research on health and medical issues with related publications in refereed international journals. Candidates should have some prior teaching experience, preferably in a medically relevant setting.

The responsibilities of this position include teaching pre-professional, pre-clinical and clinical medical and graduate students with involvement in the planning and development of a Master of Public Health degree program. Teaching is conducted in a multidisciplinary environment with other academic staff in fields such as Sociology, Psychology, Epidemiology, Ethics, Occupational and Environmental Health, Health Education, Health policy and Management and Biostatistics. The language of instruction at the Faculty of Medicine is English.
