Her current activities involve curriculum development for the newly founded Faculty of Public Health. Her current research activities are focused in following areas: use of survey data in predictive modeling for wellness programs, weight gain over lifespan, and chronic disease epidemiology.

Dr. El Reda has over 15 years of experience in public health practice across a variety of settings, such as city, county, state, federal, and private sector in the United States. Most recently, she has been focused on the application of epidemiologic and statistical principles in the assessment of primary care practice delivery for 4.5 million insured patients in Michigan using health insurance claims data. In addition, Dr. El Reda has been an Adjunct Assistant Professor with Michigan State University's College of Human Medicine teaching graduate courses in epidemiology, biostatistics, and health informatics since 2012. Dr. El Reda is an alumni of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Epidemic Intelligence Service and has published on the topics of maternal and child health, primary care practice transformation, disease prevention programs, and infectious disease outbreaks.
